#### Purpose

- Identify current activity within organisations and growth potential for volunteer/asset involvement and social prescribing related activities.
- Develop network / sharing process between organisations; *encourage organisations with established programmes and/or provision to share ideas and processes as well as support those organisations who wish to develop programmes/provision*
- Provision of identified training needs. Support organisational processes and engagement Quality; data, safeguarding etc

#### Outline – to be reported on the appropriate forms, see attached

To develop an engagement, networking, training and sharing programme that develops organisations’ ability to engage and utilise assets in the delivery of support.

This will be delivered via an adaptable engagement process that.

- Enables **established** / lead organisations to develop and share their current processes with **emerging** and **embryonic** groups.
- Developing process of groups working together
- Develop a peer support network and possible buddying system for smaller [**emerging** and **embryonic**] organisations
- Basic training – supporting smaller, **emerging** and **embryonic**, organisations – updating current policies,
  - Reviewing quality process including GDPR and safeguarding requirements
- Development of processes for partners to increase the engagement and use of active citizens
- Refer **emerging** and **embryonic** groups to Sparkbrook Aging Better Hub for potential activity funding
- Encouraging Active Citizens to network and develop activity

#### Expected Activity – Social Prescribing

- Identify current network activity, develop engagement and utilise to develop social prescribing activity.
  - Recruitment and Support organisational engagement in ‘development’ process -
  - Development of network needs and plan – negotiating with partners – development of quality measurement issues
- Provision of identified training needs. Bespoke training developed through consultation -
- Identify peer to peer learning potential – who can offer what (organisation) who needs what (individual)
  - Developing peer to peers support network
  - *Develop close links with Social Media training to enhance organisational offer*
- Developing engagement activities with groups and organisations to identify active citizens (Objective 4)
  - Providing formal and informal activities that brings groups and their identified active citizens together (Objective 1(5))
  - Provide activities for users of groups / individuals (active citizens) to widen participation and reduce isolation (Objective 1(5))
- Provide report to co-ordinator as to unmet needs and other development needs of organisations so that other activities can be developed
- Completion of required reporting process (forms 2.1, 2.2, 2.3, 2.4)
